

**Announcement on the First Session of 2025/2026 (AY114) Summer Courses
Proposed by Offering Departments and Student Course Registration and Special
Course Application**

Date of Announcement: April 29, 2026

Reference: Article 4 of NTU's Summer Course Guidelines.

Announcement:

1. The list of first-session summer courses proposed by each academic unit will be announced on April 29, 2026. Students who wish to register for these courses should do so between April 30 and May 6 via the Summer Course System → Bulletin Board → NTU Student Registration (<http://coursemap.aca.ntu.edu.tw/summer/>).
2. The number of student registrations will determine whether a course will be offered. Courses that meet the minimum registration requirement will be officially announced on June 1, 2026.
3. Students intending to register for summer courses must read the specific guidelines for each session:
 - (1) Courses such as [Calculus (1) & Calculus (3)], [Calculus 4 (Applications in Economics and Management)], [General Physics (a)(1)], [Organic Chemistry (b)(1)], [Biochemistry(b) (1)] are expected to meet the minimum enrollment and do not require pre-registration. Students may directly select these courses during the online pre-registration period indicated in the summer academic calendar.
 - (2) Some courses do not support online registration. For these, students must register in person at designated locations during the registration period.
4. If a desired course is not listed in the summer course offerings, students may apply to request a special course offering. Please go to Summer Course System → NTU Student Special Course Application, complete the "Application Form for Special Summer Course Offering," print and get it signed, and submit the approved form to the Curriculum Division, Office of Academic Affairs by May 15, 2026. Late submissions will not be accepted.
5. Restrictions for taking summer courses:
 - (1) Students who are subject to dismissal due to academic standing at the end of the second semester of the academic year are not allowed to enroll in summer courses.

(2) Students may take up to 16 credits during the summer term.
