

Notes on Enrolling in NTU Summer Sessions by non-NTU Students

Students from other universities planning to enroll in NTU summer courses may not apply for course drop/add, refunds or withdrawals. Please consider carefully before enrolling.

Tuition fees

Type 1 Course:

At the time of application, the amount of tuition is calculated based on a class size of at least 16; adjustments will be made at a later time when the actual number of enrolled students becomes known.

Note: Starting with the 2013/2014 academic year, NTU and non-NTU students will share the costs of enrolling 16 students or fewer equally. For a class with fewer than 16 students, the tuition fees are assessed as follows:

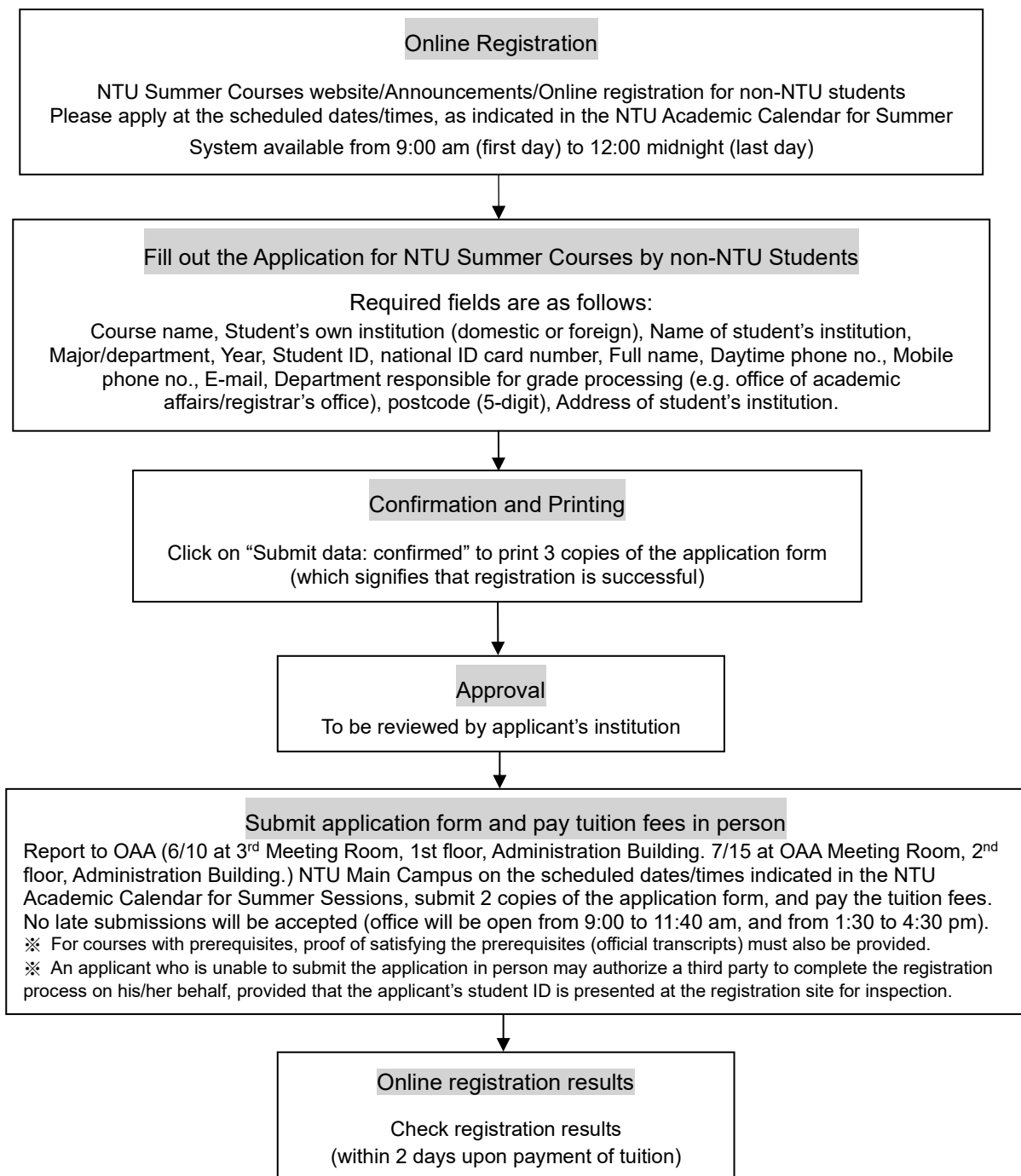
$$(\text{Course tuition per person}) \times 16 \div (\text{Actual no. of students enrolled}) + (\$1,000 \text{ admin. fee})$$

Type 2 Course:

The amount of tuition is calculated based on the standard for students in the College of Science plus an administrative fee of \$1,000.

Application Procedure

Courses open to enrollment by students from other universities will be made available for online registration at the announced date and time. Courses for which enrollment has become full will no longer be available for registration. Students who have completed the online registration process shall present their application forms and pay the tuition fees at the specified time. No late submissions or fee payments will be accepted.



Mailing of grade reports

Two weeks following the conclusion of a summer session, grade reports will be sent to the department responsible for grade processing at each student's institution. Students may not request that the grade reports be sent to them individually.
